

2. LAOS

- THE STATUS OF NORTH VIETNAMESE FORCES IN LAOS IS UNCHANGED. THEY ARE STILL THERE, PERHAPS AS MANY AS 4,000-5,000 OF THEM.
- ON WEDNESDAY AND AGAIN YESTERDAY, SOUVANNA ASSURED В. AMBASSADOR UNGER OF HIS INTENT TO TAKE A PERSONAL HAND IN GETTING THE VIETNAMESE OUT OF THE COUNTRY. SO FAR, HOWEVER, SOUVANNA'S ASSURANCES HAVE BEEN SOMEWHAT LONGER THAN HIS PER-50X1 FORMANCE.

D. WE ARE NOT CONFIDENT, HOWEVER, THAT ANY PLOY IS GO-ING TO GET THE COMMUNISTS TO MOVE IN A HURRY. IN MOSCOW, THE LINE IS THAT SOUVANNA'S STATEMENT LAST SUNDAY JUST ABOUT

CLOSES THE BOOK ON WITHDRAWAL. TO THE SOVIETS, SOUVANNA'S REFERENCE TO "STRAGGLERS" MEANS CHINATS, THAIS, AND FILI-PINOS.

- E. WE ARE SEEING MORE INDICATIONS OF DISSENSION WITHIN THE NEUTRALIST CAMP. THE LATEST WE HAVE IS A REPORT OF A DEVELOPING CLASH OF PERSONALITIES BETWEEN SOUVANNA AND HIS FOREIGN MINISTER. QUINIM.
- F. THIS DOES NOT AUGUR WELL FOR LAOTIAN NEUTRALITY.

5. CONGO

- A. THE PRESSURES THAT HAVE BEEN APPLIED ON TSHOMBE IN THE PAST FORTNIGHT HAVE WRENCHED MORE CONCILIATORY GESTURES FROM HIM. HE HAS NOW OFFERED TO TURN OVER 25 PERCENT OF KATANGA'S REVENUES TO THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT AND SHOWN SOME GIVE IN HIS POSITION CONCERNING A CEASE-FIRE.
- B. UN CHIEF GARDINER STILL FEELS THAT HE CANNOT, IN GOOD CONSCIENCE, REPORT THAT TSHOMBE IS MOVING TO IMPLEMENT THE UN'S REINTEGRATION PLAN IN GOOD FAITH. HE IS WITHHOLDING FINAL JUDGEMENT, HOWEVER, UNTIL AFTER HE TACKLES TSHOMBE TODAY ON THE MILITARY PROVISIONS OF THE PLAN.

C. ALBERT KALONJI, "KING" OF SOUTH KASAI, SHOWED UP HALE AND HEARTY IN ELISABETHVILLE YESTERDAY WHERE, WE SUS-PECT, HE WILL SEEK TO MAKE COMMON CAUSE WITH TSHOMBE AGAINST LEOPOLDVILLE.
