

Bread and wine

Forreshadows of the bread and wine in the end times are throughout scripture

When Christ returns He brings the bread and the wine as the order of Melkezedek King and Priest.

Here is the new wine and bread He brings found in foreshadows.

First the bread is found in the Ark.

Exodus 16:33 And Moses said unto Aaron, Take a pot, and put an omer **full of manna therein**, and lay it up before the Lord, to be kept for your generations.

34 As the Lord commanded Moses, so Aaron **laid it up before the Testimony**, to be kept.

They put manna in the Ark of the Testimony which is the Bread.

John 6:31 Our fathers did **eat manna** in the desert; as it is written, **He gave them bread from heaven to eat.**

The Ark of the Testiment is sent before the WAR.

Numbers 10:35 And it came to pass, **when the ark set forward**, that Moses said, **Rise up, Lord, and let thine enemies be scattered**; and let them that hate thee **flee before thee.**

The armies brought the ARK into battle after the 7 trumpets were blown.

Joshua 6:6 And Joshua the son of Nun called the priests, and said unto them, **Take up the ark of the covenant**, and let seven priests bear seven trumpets of rams' horns **before the ark of the Lord.**

Joshua 6:9 And **the armed men** went before the priests that blew with the trumpets, and the rereward **came after the ark**, the priests going on, and blowing with the trumpets.

At the seventh trumpet we see the ARK coming to the WAR.

On Christs return the temple of God is opened in Heaven and the Ark of the Testimony is seen.

Rev 11:15 **And the seventh angel sounded**; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

Rev 11:19 And the **temple of God was opened in heaven**, and there was seen in his **temple the ark of his testament**: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.

This is Christ coming out to make WAR.

Before Christ left He said he will not partake of the fruit of the vine until the day He returns.

Matt 26:29 But I say unto you, **I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine**, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.

The wine was represented by His blood shed. The new wine coming is not from literal grapes.

Here is Christ treading the winepress of those who oppose Him on His return.

Rev 14:14 And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto **the Son of man**, having on his head a golden crown, and in **his hand a sharp sickle**.

15 And another angel came **out of the temple**, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, **Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe**.

Rev 14:18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, **Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe**.

19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

20 And the winepress was trodden without the city, and **blood came out of the winepress**, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs.

And again in Joel this is seen on the day of the LORD this wine.

Joel 3:13 **Put ye in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe**: come, get you down; for the **press is full**, the fats overflow; for their wickedness is great.

14 Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision: for **the day of the Lord** is near in the valley of decision.

Joel 3:18 And it shall **come to pass in that day, that the mountains shall drop down new wine**, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters, and a fountain shall come forth out of the house of the Lord, and shall water the valley of Shittim.

This is also seen in Isaiah

Isaiah 34:3 Their slain also shall be cast out, and their stink shall come up out of their carcasses, and **the mountains shall be melted with their blood**.

This is also foretold in Amos.

Amos 9:13 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and **the treader of grapes him that soweth seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt**.

The day of the Lord wine river of blood.

Ezek 32:6 **I will also water with thy blood the land wherein thou swimmest, even to the mountains; and the rivers shall be full of thee**.

7 And when I shall put thee out, I will cover the heaven, and make the stars thereof dark; I will cover the sun with a cloud, and the moon shall not give her light.

The one who judges and makes war returning to turn those who fight into a river of blood.

Rev19: 11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and **make WAR.**

13 And he was clothed with a **vesture dipped in blood:** and his name is called The Word of God.

14 And **the armies which were in heaven followed him** upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and **he treadeth the winepress** of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

16 And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, **King Of Kings,** And Lord Of Lords.

The one who returns from Edom clothed in a vesture dipped in blood from treading the winepress.

Isaiah 63:63 **Who is this that cometh from Edom,** with **dyed garments** from Bozrah? this that is glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

2 Wherefore art **thou red in thine apparel,** and thy garments like **him that treadeth in the winefat?**

3 **I have trodden the winepress alone;** and of the people there was none with me: for **I will tread them in mine anger,** and **trample them in my fury;** and **their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.**

4 For the day of vengeance is in mine heart, and the year of my redeemed is come.

6 And I will tread down the people in mine anger, and make them drunk in my fury, and I will bring down their strength to the earth.

The story of Elisha foreshadows those who will be spared who fight the King of Israel.

2 kings 3:6 And king Jehoram went out of Samaria the same time, and numbered all Israel.

7 And he went and sent to Jehoshaphat the king of Judah, saying, The king of Moab hath rebelled against me: wilt thou go **with me against Moab to battle?** And he said, I will go up: I am as thou art, my people as thy people, and my horses as thy horses.

8 And he said, Which way shall we go up? And he answered, **The way through the wilderness of Edom.**

They went through the way of EDOM in the wilderness uring the time of Battle.

They enquired of the prophet.

2 kings 3:11 But Jehoshaphat said, **Is there not here a prophet of the Lord, that we may enquire of the Lord by him?** And one of the king of Israel's servants answered and said, Here is Elisha the son of Shaphat, which poured water on the hands of Elijah.

The water was provided to those in the wilderness to those preparing for battle.

2 kings 3:16 And he said, Thus saith the Lord, Make this valley full of ditches.

17 For thus saith the Lord, Ye shall not see wind, neither shall ye see rain; yet that **valley shall be filled with water, that ye may drink**, both ye, and your cattle, and your beasts.

The water came up to the camp to help those in the wilderness preparing for battle.

2 kings 3:20 And it came to pass in the morning, when the meat offering was offered, that, behold, there **came water by the way of Edom, and the country was filled with water.**

21 And when all **the Moabites heard that the kings were come up to fight against them**, they gathered all that were able to put on armour, and upward, and stood in the border.

The moabites then came to battle.

22 And they rose up early in the morning, and the sun shone upon the water, and **the Moabites saw the water on the other side as red as blood:**

They saw the river as blood and fled.

23 And they said, **This is blood: the kings are surely slain, and they have smitten one another:** now therefore, Moab, to the spoil.

24 And when they came to the camp of Israel, the Israelites rose up and smote the Moabites, so that **they fled before them:** but they went forward smiting the Moabites, even in their country.

Christ in His mercy shared this divine revelation through turning water to wine for the end.

Did not Jesus turn the water to wine to let you know the best wine is for last?

John 2:7 Jesus saith unto them, **Fill the waterpots with water.** And they filled them up to the brim.

8 And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it.

9 When the ruler of the feast had tasted **the water that was made wine**, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom,

10 And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: **but thou hast kept the good wine until now.**

Just like the water was turned to wine, the rivers will be turned to blood at the end times.

Some of the grapes will be spared and permitted to remain on the earth for those who bend thier knee to our King and surrender at seeing the river of blood if they turn from fighting.

Just as it was revealed to those who fight the king of israel of old during days of Elisha.

They saw the blood river and fled. Those who bend thier knee seeing the blood river will be spared.

Isaiah 65:8 **Thus saith the Lord, As the new wine** is found in the cluster, and one saith, Destroy it not; for a blessing is in it: **so will I do for my servants' sakes, that I may not destroy them all.**

Christ will be bring the ark with BREAD in it and the WINE for the end.
