

It is finished.

The work that was supposed to be done was left undone this is a foreshadow of end times.

Matt 23:23 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithes of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: **these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.**

The pharisees were in charge of the work the first coming of Christ and he rebuked them they left things undone.

The second coming he rebukes the church people also for things being undone same as pharisees.

Jesus then finished the work that He was sent to do by shedding blood in Jerusalem.

John 19:29 Now there was set a vessel full of vinegar: and they filled a sponge with vinegar, and put it upon hyssop, and put it to his mouth.

30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, **It is finished:** and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

Jesus said it is finished. The work He was sent to do was finished.

The mystery of God to be revealed will be finished through the tribulation with the prophesying until all it is fulfilled.

Which will be in the last day of the 1260 days of the seventh angel.

Rev 10:7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the **mystery of God should be finished**, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.

It will be 1260 days of prophesying until the last day at the last trumpet when the last drops of blood shed in Jerusalem with the two prophets at the end of the 1260 days.

Rev 16:17 And **the seventh angel** poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, **It is done.**

The seventh trumpet and seventh bowl is at the end of the 1260 days and the declaration of its done.

Rev 10:7 But in the days of **the voice of the seventh angel**, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God **should be finished**, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.

The mystery of God will be finished.

The finishing of the work "it is done" when all the things that are written to be fulfilled with the last drops of blood shed in Jerusalem.

It is finished.
