2. MEXICO-USSR:

- A. THE USSR HAS APPARENTLY OFFERED TO CONCLUDE A TRADE AGREEMENT WITH MEXICO.
- B. MOSCOW IS PREPARED TO GRANT LONG-TERM CREDITS AND ASSISTANCE ON VARIOUS INDUSTRIAL PROJECTS,

C. WE HAVE VERY FEW DETAILS AND NO INDICATION OF MEXICAN RECEPTIVITY TO THE OFFER. WE DO KNOW THAT IN THE PAST SOVIET-MEXICAN TRADE HAS BEEN MINISCULE, WITH THE FEW SOVIET GOODS THUS FAR IMPORTED BY MEXICO PROVING TO BE OF INFERIOR QUALITY.

3. LAOS:

- A. AFTER FURTHER MANEUVERING, SOUVANNA AND SOUPHANNOU-VONG MAY AGREE TO HOLD THEIR TRIPARTITE MEETING IN GENEVA.
- B. SOUVANNA IS STICKING TO HIS POSITION THAT THE MEETING WILL FIRST HAVE TO DEAL WITH A CEASEFIRE AND RETURN TO THE

 STATUS QUO ANTE BEFORE PICKING A LAOTIAN DELEGATION TO A 14NATION CONFERENCE.
 - C. THE MILITARY SITUATION REMAINS QUIET.

4. HONDURAS-US:

- A. THE HONDURANS ARE STILL CONDUCTING THEIR INVESTIGA-TION OF THE NINE US SHRIMPBOATS PICKED UP ON THURSDAY.
- B. THE HONDURAN FOREIGN MINISTER SAID YESTERDAY THEY
 WERE WELL WITHIN THE 12-MILE LIMIT CLAIMED BY HONDURAS,
 ALTHOUGH THE US EMBASSY HAD RECEIVED A REPORT THAT THE BOATS
 WERE OUT ABOUT 30 MILES.
- C. HE ASSURED THE EMBASSY THAT HONDURAS WANTED TO SETTLE
 THE MATTER QUICKLY AND NOT DETAIN THE BOATS ANY LONGER THAN
 NECESSARY. HE WAS FIRM, HOWEVER, IN INSISTING THAT HIS GOVERNMENT INTENDS TO INFORCE ITS LAW IF THE INVESTIGATION SUPPORTS
 HIS ACCOUNT OF THE INCIDENT.

5. NOTES:

- A. MEXICO-US: MEXICAN OFFICIALS, INCLUDING AMBASSADOR
 CARRILLO FLORES FROM WASHINGTON, WILL MEET THIS MONDAY TO CONSIDER THE US PROPOSAL ON THE SALINITY PROBLEM. OUR EMBASSY
 NOTES THAT THE 12 JULY DATE FOR COUNTRY-WIDE DEMONSTRATIONS
 HAS BEEN PUSHED PACK TO 9 AUGUST.
- B. TANGANYIKA-ZANZIBAR: THE USSR HAS NOW COMPLIED WITH DAR-ES-SALAAM'S 1 JULY DIRECTIVE AND REDUCED ITS EMBASSY ON ZANZIBAR TO A CONSULATE. AT LAST REPORT THE EAST GERMANS WERE STILL HOLDING OUT.

E. BERLIN AIR CORRIDOR: A SOVIET INTERCEPTOR MILDLY HARASSED A US ARMY MOHAWK OBSERVATION PLANE FLYING THE SOUTH AIR CORRIDOR TO BERLIN YESTERDAY AFTERNOON. NO SHOTS WERE FIRED; THE INTERCEPTOR MERELY WAGGLED ITS WINGS AND FLEW NEAR THE MOHAWK WITHOUT INTERFERING WITH ITS FLIGHT. A US PROTEST HAS BEEN DELIVERED TO THE SOVIET AIR CONTROLLER, WHO HAD SAID WHEN THE FLIGHT PLAN WAS FILED THAT HE CONSIDERED THE MOHAWK TO BE A COMBAT PLANE AND COULD NOT THEREFORE GUARANTEE ITS SAFETY.
