

BEFORE USING THIS MEDICINE: WHAT DO I NEED TO TELL MY DOCTOR BEFORE I TAKE THIS DRUG? TELL YOUR DOCTOR: If you are allergic to this drug; any part of this drug; or any other drugs, foods, or substances. Tell your doctor about the allergy and what signs you had. TELL YOUR DOCTOR: If you have any of these health problems: Bone problems, joint problems, kidney problems, or ulcers. TELL YOUR DOCTOR: If the fluoride in your drinking water is greater than or equal to 0.6 parts per million. This is not a list of all drugs or health per fillion.
