

Temple power

The prophesy of the end times temple of God filled with power is foreshadowed in two witnesses of the past.

First when the temple of God was filled with power in the time of Solomon.

2 Chron 5:12 Also the Levites which were the singers, all of them of Asaph, of Heman, of Jeduthun, with their sons and their brethren, being arrayed in white linen, having cymbals and psalteries and harps, stood at the east end of the altar, and with them **an hundred and twenty priests** sounding with trumpets:)

120 priests were there at the Temple and the Spirit of God filled the temple to where no man could enter the temple of God.

2 Chron 5:13 It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the Lord; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised the Lord, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: that **then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the Lord;**

14 So that **the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud:** for the glory of the Lord had filled the house of God.

This is seen in the second witness of the day of Pentecost.

The disciples were gathered 120 disciples in prayer..

Acts 1:15 And in those days Peter stood up in the midst of the disciples, and said, **(the number of names together were about an hundred and twenty,)**

Then two were chosen..

Acts 1:23 And **they appointed two**, Joseph called Barsabas, who was surnamed Justus, and Matthias.

24 And they prayed, and said, Thou, Lord, which knowest the hearts of all men, shew whether of these two thou hast chosen,

on the day of Pentecost they were all there on one accord.

Acts 2:1 And **when the day of Pentecost was fully come**, they were all with one accord in one place.

Then the Temple of God was filled with the Spirit and their tongues were as tongues of fire.

Acts 2:2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled **all the house where they were sitting.**

3 And there appeared unto them cloven **tongues like as of fire**, and it sat upon each of them.

4 And they **were all filled with the Holy Ghost**, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

That all nations under heaven heard.

Act 2:5 And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, **out of every nation under heaven.**

6 Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that **every man heard them speak in his own language.**

This is the foreshadow second witness account of what will occur in the end times.

Things on earth will be as in heaven for the end times.

Temple of God in heaven will be filled with power for 1260 days and the temple of God on earth with its lampstands filled with power for 1260 days on earth as it is in heaven.

Two are chosen filled with power.

Rev 11:3 And **I will give power** unto **my two witnesses**, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Temple items filled with power which are candlesticks from the Temple of God.

Rev 11:4 These are the two olive trees, and the **two candlesticks** standing before the God of the earth.

Tongues of fire occur just as the day of pentecost.

Rev 11:5 And if any man will hurt them, **fire proceedeth out of their mouth**, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

All the nations will hear the message.

During which the message of the prophesy 1260 days the Temple of God in heaven is also filled with power that no man may enter until the prophesy is finished with the plagues...

Rev 15:8 And **the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power**; and **no man was able to enter into the temple**, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.

This is the foreshadow of the end times in the two witnesses in earth as it is in heaven.
