

Islam worship

Challenge to Islam about Worship of Christ.

Muslims... you always say that Christ never said to worship Him.

Your account in the hadith describes judgement of Christians falling into hell on the day of the Resurrection....

**Volume 6, Book 60, Number 105:** Narrated Abu Said Al-Khudri: ..... The Prophet said, "(Similarly) you will have no difficulty in seeing Allah on the Day of Resurrection as you have no difficulty in seeing either of them. On the Day of Resurrection, a call-maker will announce, "Let every nation follow that which they used to worship." Then none of those who used to worship anything other than Allah like idols and other deities but will fall in Hell (Fire), till there will remain none but those who used to worship Allah, both those who were obedient (i.e. good) and those who were disobedient (i.e. bad) and the remaining party of the people of the Scripture. .... Afterwards the Christians will be called upon and it will be said to them, 'Who do you use to worship?' They will say, 'We used to worship Jesus, the son of Allah.' It will be said to them, 'You are liars, for Allah has never taken anyone as a wife or a son,' Then it will be said to them, 'What do you want?' They will say what the former people have said. Then, when there remain (in the gathering) none but those who used to worship Allah (Alone, the real Lord of the Worlds) whether they were obedient or disobedient. Then (Allah) the Lord of the worlds will come to them **in a shape nearest to the picture they had in their minds about Him.** It will be said, 'What are you waiting for?' Every nation have followed what they used to worship.' They will reply, 'We left the people in the world when we were in great need of them and we did not take them as friends. Now we are waiting for our Lord Whom we used to worship.' Allah will say, 'I am your Lord.' They will say twice or thrice, 'We do not worship any besides Allah.' "

The account is clear.

Luke 24:49 And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

Luke 24:50 And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and **he lifted up his hands, and blessed them.**

Luke 24:51 And it came to pass, while he blessed them, he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven.

Luke 24:52 And **THEY WORSHIPPED HIM**, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy:

If you believe Christ is prophet would he bless them knowing theyd worship him without first warning them not to worship him as he departs?

Or how about the angel who warns John not to worship him.

Rev 19:10 And **I fell at his feet to worship him.** And he said unto me, **See thou do it not:** I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

IF an angel would warn the apostle not to worship him wouldnt you think it would be even more clearer to the apostles in their writings to not worship Christ or expressivly write Christ warned them not to worship Him?

When John fell dead before the Lords feet to worship Him Christ did not warn him.

Rev 1:17 And when **I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead.** And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last:

Why were the wisemen and Mary permiting worship of Christ?

Matt 2:2 Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are **come to worship him.**

Herod of the king of the Jews said he would worship Christ with the wisemen.

Matt 2:8 And he sent them to Bethlehem, and said, Go and search diligently for the young child; and when ye have found him, bring me word again, **that I may come and worship him also.**

Or how about what the apostles shared about worshipping the Son of God?

Heb 1:5 For unto which of the angels said he at any time, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee? And again, I will be to him a Father, and he shall be to me a Son?

6 And again, **when he bringeth in the firstbegotten into the world, he saith, And let all the angels of God worship him.**

Why did Christ not rebuke those worshipping Him calling him the Son of God?

Matt 14:33 Then they that were in the ship came and **worshipped him**, saying, Of a truth **thou art the Son of God**.

The worship of Christ occurred at His birth, during his life and after He ascended to heaven.

The worship of the Lamb of God who is Christ is occurring in heaven. ...

Heaven angels and elders are seen worshipping the Lamb of God which is Christ.

Rev 11:11 And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands;

**12 Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb** that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.

**13 And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.**

**14 And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four and twenty elders fell down and worshipped him that liveth for ever and ever.**

The truth is, it is you who will be the ones tossed to the flames on the day of Resurrection for not worshipping Christ the Son of God and there will be no games played with you.

You will bow your knee and worship the Son of God now or you will bow your knee to the Son of God and worship Him on your way to the flames.

Choice is yours.

Worship the Son of God and be spared.

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
