THE PRESIDENT'S INTELLIGENCE CHECKLIST -- 9 AUGUST 1964

- CYPRUS: (Information as of 0800 EDT)
- A. TEMPERS AND EMOTIONS ARE AT CRITICAL LEVELS IN GREECE AND TURKEY, AND A POWDER KEG SITUATION EXISTS ON CYPRUS AS A RESULT OF THE DEVELOPMENTS OF THE PAST 24 HOURS.
- B. MAKARIOS HAS ASKED THE USSR TO INTERVENE TO STOP A TURKISH INVASION.
- C. WE HAVE HEARD NOTHING YET OF A SOVIET RESPONSE. BELIEVE, HOWEVER, THAT MOSCOW IS UNLIKELY TO DO ANYTHING MORE THAN TRY TO GET WHAT PROPAGANDA BENEFIT IT CAN OUT OF THE SITUATION.
