## 1. LAOS:

- A. THERE WERE NO BIG DEVELOPMENTS ON THE GROUND YES-TERDAY.
- B. KONG LE'S NEUTRALIST FORCES, ALONG WITH THE MEO
  GUERRILLAS, STILL HOLD THE HILLS TO THE WEST AND NORTH OF
  THE PLAINE DES JARRES. AS YET THE PATHET LAO HAVE MADE NO
  SERIOUS EFFORT TO DISLODGE THEM.

- D. THE NEWS FROM NORTH KATANGA IS BETTER. GOVERNMENT TROOPS LANDED AT ALBERTVILLE YESTERDAY, AND AT LAST REPORT HAD RE-ESTABLISHED CONTROL--AT LEAST FOR THE MOMENT.
- E. UNLESS THE CONGOLESE ARMY DOES BETTER BEFORE THE DEPARTURE OF ALL UN FORCES BY THE END OF JUNE, THE ANTI-ADOULA INFECTION IS BOUND TO SPREAD. REPORTS FROM STANLEY-VILLE, FOR EXAMPLE, STATE THAT ADOULA'S ENEMIES ARE ALREADY ACTIVE AGAIN THERE.
- F. MOBUTU HAS STILL NOT SHOWED UP IN THE CONGO TO RALLY HIS DISPIRITED CHARGES.
- G. TSHOMBE, HOWEVER, MAY BE LESS RELUCTANT. HE LET IT DROP THIS WEEK THAT HE DOES NOT INTEND TO STAY IN SPAIN "INDEFINITELY." NOW, WE HEAR, HE IS ABOUT TO RECEIVE A SPECIAL EMISSARY FROM SPAAK.

## 3. RUMANIA:

- A. THE ROUND OF ANTI-KHRUSHCHEV, ANTI-SOVIET RALLIES IS HAVING AN EXTRAORDINARY IMPACT ON THE RUMANIAN MAN IN THE STREET.
- B. ACCORDING TO WHAT THE US LEGATION HEARS, THE RUMANIANS HAVE REACTED WITH "ELATION, INCREDULITY AND AD-MIRATION" FOR THE WAY THE GOVERNMENT IS EXPRESSING ITS INDE-PENDENCE.

- C. GRATIFYING AS THIS MUST BE, THE GOVERNMENT IS STILL
  A BIT DISTURBED SINCE THE RESPONSE IN SOME CASES HAS BEEN
  STRONGER THAN WAS DESIRED.
- D. THE LEGATION FEELS THAT THIS COULD LEAD THE AUTHORITIES TO BEAT A TACTICAL RETREAT TO TAKE SOME OF THE EDGE
  OFF. WE WOULD NOT EXPECT, HOWEVER, THAT THEY WILL GO SO FAR
  AS TO ABANDON THEIR PROUD NEW INDEPENDENT COURSE.
- E. THAT COURSE IS ALREADY HAVING AN IMPACT IN OTHER EAST EUROPEAN STATES. WE HEAR, FOR EXAMPLE, THAT VOICES ARE BEING RAISED IN HIGH CZECH CIRCLES IN FAVOR OF SOME PUBLIC SHOW OF INDEPENDENCE FROM THE USSR.

## 4. CYPRUS:

- A. HAVING BEEN HANDED A LIVE ISSUE WITH THE CAPTURE OF THE ERRANT AIRMAN, THE GREEK CYPRIOTS HAVE STIRRED UP AN ANTI-BRITISH CAMPAIGN.
- B. IT HAS INCLUDED "GET OUT OF CYPRUS" DEMONSTRATIONS
  IN ALL MAJOR CITIES AND THE HARASSMENT OF BRITISH TRAFFIC AT
  CHECKPOINTS ALL ABOUT THE ISLAND. UN OFFICIALS ARE FEARFUL
  THAT THIS WILL LEAD TO EVEN MORE SERIOUS TROUBLE.
- C. SO FAR THE US HAS NOT BEEN INVOLVED IN THE AGITATION

  AGAINST THE BRITISH THOUGH THIS HAS HAPPENED IN PREVIOUS CASES.
- D. THERE IS MOUNTING CONCERN IN ANKARA OVER THE IMPLICATIONS FOR TURKISH SECURITY OF THE ACQUISITION OF MORE WEAPONS BY THE GREEK CYPRIOTS.

- E. AS MATTERS NOW STAND, THE GREEK CYPRIOTS HAVE ENOUGH SMALL ARMS FOR A FORCE OF 35,000. RECENT ACQUISITIONS INCLUDE LIGHT TANKS AND LIGHT AIRCRAFT. ARTILLERY IS EXPECTED FROM CAIRO MOMENTARILY.
- F. IN CONTRAST TO THIS THE TURKISH CYPRIOTS, THOUGH RE-CEIVING SOME ARMS AND MEN, PROBABLY CAN EQUIP NO MORE THAN 10,000 AT THIS TIME.

- C. PANAMA: ROBLES WAS OFFICIALLY DECLARED PRESIDENT-ELECT YESTERDAY. ARIAS AND HIS FOLLOWERS ARE CRYING "FRAUD," AND THREATENING TO TAKE STEPS. SO FAR THE NATIONAL GUARD HAS EASILY HANDLED THE SITUATION.
- D. INDIA: NO ACTION WAS TAKEN YESTERDAY TO FIX ON NEHRU'S SUCCESSOR. DESPITE INTENSE MANEUVERING, ESPECIALLY BY RIGHT-WING SUPPORTERS OF MORARJI DESAI, SHASTRI'S SELECTION, POSSIBLY TODAY, APPEARS LIKELY.
