

Two resurrect.

The account of Christs Resurrection will be testified of to the entire earth.

The matter will be established by two witnesses.

Deut 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: **at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.**

The two prophets are two witnesses that will testify of this.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses**, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Christs death burial and resurrection will at the last day be seen by the entire earth by two prophets.

Christ was killed at Jerusalem and raised on the third day.

Matt 16:21 From that time forth began Jesus to shew unto his disciples, **how that he must go unto Jerusalem**, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and **be killed, and be raised again the third day.**

The Resurrection of Christ will have evidence of this that the whole world will see by two witnesses being killed at Jerusalem and Resurrected on third day.

Rev 11:7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and **kill them.**

They will be killed like Christ was killed at Jerusalem.

Rev 11:8 And **their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city**, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, **where also our Lord was crucified.**

Killed laying in the streets of Jerusalem where the Lord was crucified.

Rev 11:9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half, and **shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.**

The whole world can see of the peoples ntions and tongues. The bodies prevented from being put into graves so no tricks can occur taking bodies as muslims claim was done by Christ and Jews.

The world will rejoice and see the Two prophets dead.

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these **two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.**

Then on the Third Day just as Christ was Resurrected they will Resurrect in sight of the world.

Rev 11:11 And **after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them,** and they **stood upon their feet;** and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

The whole world will see the Resurrection of Jesus Christ testified in the death of two prophets resurrecting in the sight of the entire world.

That all men will be without excuse rejecting that the Son of God was killed and Resurrected on the Third Day.

Two will be witnesses of this that the matter is established.
