

**5 AUGUST 1961 CHECKLIST (COPY)**

**1. ULBRICHT POSITION LOOKS SHAKY. HIS PRESENCE IN MOSCOW FOR THE PAST SEVERAL DAYS IS NOW CONFIRMED. IN VIEW OF EAST GERMANY'S ECONOMIC PREDICAMENT AND ULBRICHT'S FAILURE TO STEM THE REFUGEE FLOW, HE SHAPES UP MORE AS A BURDEN THAN AN ASSET TO THE KREMLIN. THE REFUGEES CONTINUE TO LEAVE AT A RATE WELL ABOVE A THOUSAND A DAY DESPITE STIFFENED EAST GERMAN POLICE CONTROLS.** [REDACTED] 50X1

**2. CONGO. UN OFFICIALS IN THE CONGO HAVE AGAINN STATED THAT THE UN WILL NOT OPPOSE ANY MOVES BY THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT TO REINTEGRATE KATANGA, AND HAMMARSKJOLD, [REDACTED], HAS INDICATED THAT THE UN IS MAKING PLANS TO DISARM THE KATANGAN ARMY.**

[REDACTED] **MEANWHILE, IN STANLEYVILLE, GIZENGA IS MAINTAINING HIS PUBLIC SILENCE, BUT HE HAS APPEALED URGENTLY TO CAIRO FOR HELP IN SHORING UP HIS MILITARY POSITION.** [REDACTED] 50X1

**3. TUNISIA: AS OF 0900 TODAY NO SIGNIFICANT NEW DEVELOPMENTS SINCE YESTERDAY HAD BEEN REPORTED.**

**4. CUBA. [REDACTED] ALL CUBAN PORTS WERE CLOSED AND ALL AIRCRAFT DEPARTURES FORBIDDEN, EFFECTIVE LAST MIDNIGHT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. ALMOST SIMULTANEOUSLY, THE POLICE COMMANDS IN SANTIAGO DE CUBA AND CAMAGUEY WERE PLACED ON ALERT. THE OPERATION HAS THE EARMARKS OF AN INTERNAL SECURITY FREEZE, BUT WE ARE SEEKING CLARIFICATION.** [REDACTED] 50X1
