DECEMBER BY KHRUSHCHEV IS ONE OF THE POINTS AT ISSUE. THE  
CHINESE IMPLY THAT THE NEW SOVIET LEADERS COULD POSTPONE IT  
GRACEFULLY BY BLAMING IT ON HIM.

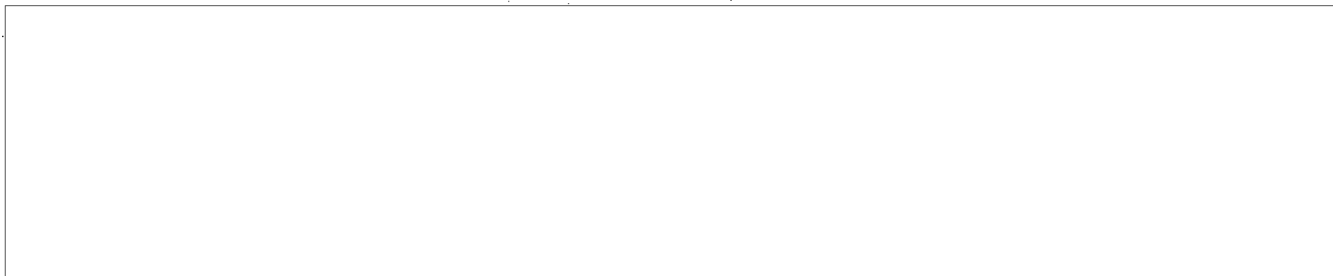

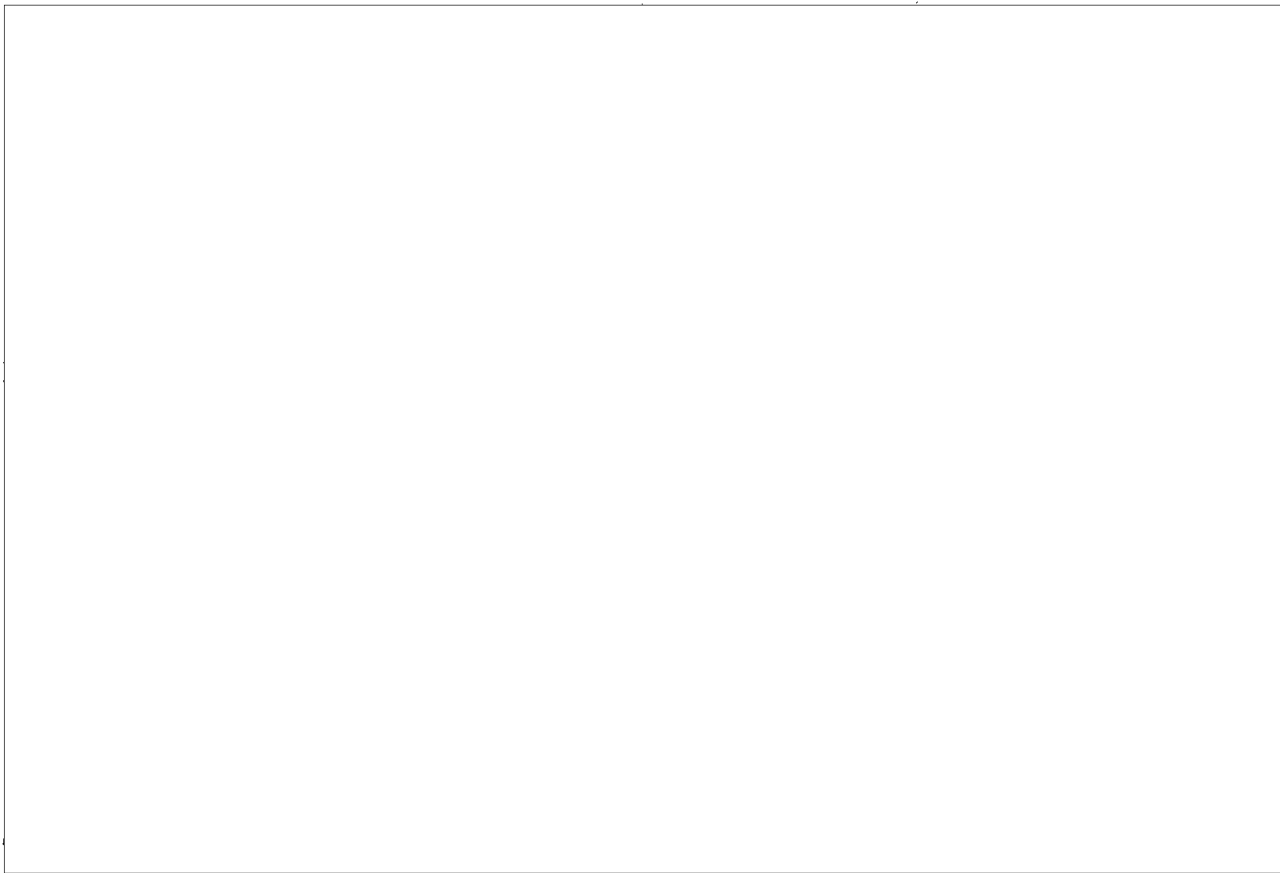

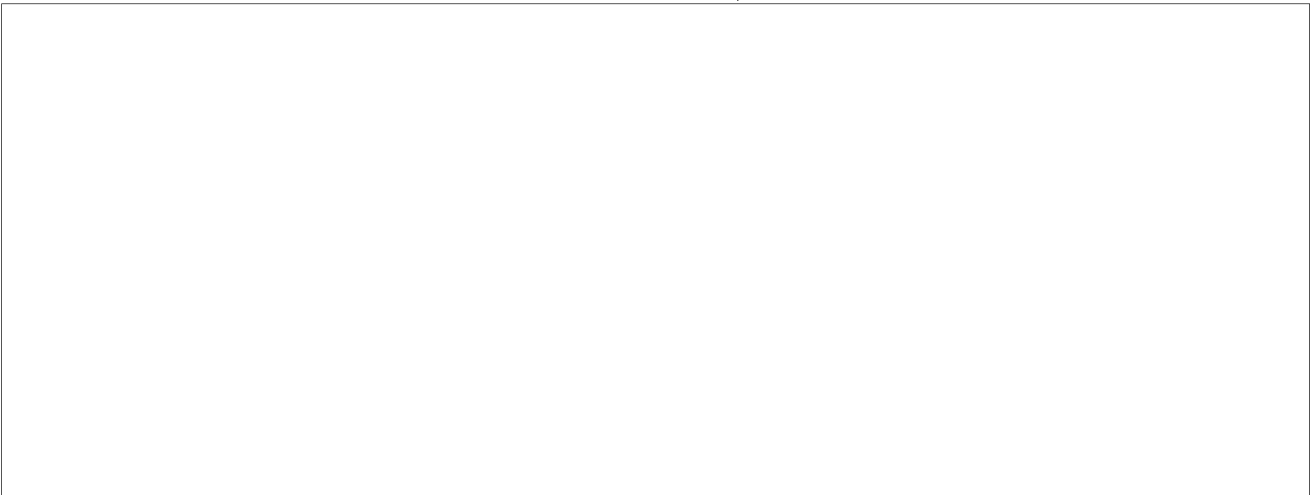

6. NOTES:

A. SUDAN: MODERATE NON-COMMUNIST POLITICIANS WITHIN THE NEW REGIME SEEM TO BE PULLING THEMSELVES TOGETHER IN AN EFFORT TO BLOCK COMMUNIST DESIGNS FOR THE NEW SUPREME EXECUTIVE NOW BEING CONSTRUCTED. NASIR IS EYEING THE SUDAN UNEASILY, WORRIED OVER THE POSSIBLE CONTAGIOUS EFFECT OF SUDANESE CHAOS ON HIS OWN DOMESTIC SITUATION.

B. UN-USSR: THE EFFORTS CONTINUE IN NEW YORK TO FIND A SOLUTION TO THE ASSESSMENTS ISSUE, BUT THE SOVIETS STILL TALK TOUGH. THREE SOVIET DEPUTY FOREIGN MINISTERS ARE TOURING AFRICA, THE MIDDLE EAST, AND ASIA TO DRUM UP SUPPORT.

GROUPS ARE MEETING SECRETLY NEXT WEEK TO PLAN THEIR ACTIONS OVER THE CANAL ISSUE. ALREADY, COMMUNIST AGITATION HAS BEGUN AGAIN. PRO-COMMUNIST DEPUTIES ARE EXPECTED TO STIR UP THE SECRET NATIONAL ASSEMBLY SESSION ON THE HANDLING OF THE CANAL PROBLEM WHICH IS SCHEDULED FOR MONDAY.

E. LAOS: THIS MORNING A US RF-101 WAS DOWNED BY GROUND FIRE BETWEEN SAVANNAKHET AND TCHEPONE, 12 MILES FROM THE F-100 DOWNED ON WEDNESDAY. THE PILOT WAS RESCUED BUT IS IN SERIOUS CONDITION. HOWEVER, WHILE THIS WAS BEING ACCOMPLISHED, A US HELICOPTER WAS SHOT DOWN 18 MILES TO THE NORTH.
