

Two elders.

The Elder of the Book of Revelation.

This will clarify who the elder speaking to apostle John is in the book of Revelation.

First context is that two are seen speaking to each other and apostle and one of the elders.

Rev 7:13 And **one of the elders** answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they?

14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Rev 5:4 And **I wept much**, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.

5 And **one of the elders** saith unto me, **Weep not**: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

John is seen weeping but the elder consoles to not weep.

Those who weep now will rejoice latter and those who weep now will not weep latter.

Luke 6:26 Woe unto you that are full! for ye shall hunger. **Woe unto you that laugh now! for ye shall mourn and weep.**

John is weeping now and the elder is letting him know not to weep.

This alludes to the elder already has wept in the past.

Joseph had wept .

Genesis 43 :30 And Joseph made haste; for his bowels did yearn upon his brother: and he sought where to weep; and he entered into his chamber, and **wept there.**

Genesis 50:17 So shall ye say unto Joseph, Forgive, I pray thee now, the trespass of thy brethren, and their sin; for they did unto thee evil: and now, we pray thee, forgive the trespass of the servants of the God of thy father. And **Joseph wept** when they spake unto him.

There are twenty four elders.

Rev 4:4 And round about the throne were **four and twenty seats**: and upon the seats **I saw four and twenty elders sitting**, clothed in white raiment; and they had **on their heads crowns of gold.**

We see that there are twenty four elders with crown of gold.

This is twelve Tribes heads and Twelve apostles.

There were twelve of the tribes with one favoured whom whom Israel loved.

Genesis 37:3 Now **Israel loved Joseph more than all his children**, because he was the son of his old age: and he made him a coat of many colours.

Genesis 49: 26 The blessings of thy father have prevailed above the blessings of my progenitors unto the utmost bound of the everlasting hills: **they shall be on the head of Joseph**, and on the **crown of the head of him** that was separate from his brethren.

There are twelve disciples one whom Jesus loved the one whom Jesus loved sitting next to him which is John the apostle leading on him.

John 13:23 Now there **was leaning on Jesus' bosom one of his disciples, whom Jesus loved.**

Twelve tribes had a betrayer DAN who was a serpent.

Joseph was betrayed by one of his brothers suggesting to be killed.

Genesis 37:20 **Come now therefore, and let us slay him**, and cast him into some pit, and we will say, Some evil beast hath devoured him: and we shall see what will become of his dreams.

This is the work of the serpent by the way who is Dan.

Genesis 39:17 **Dan shall be a serpent by the way**, an adder in the path, that biteth the horse heels, so that his rider shall fall backward.

This is why Dan is not mentioned in the tribes in the end times.

Rev 7:5 Of the tribe of **Juda** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of **Reuben** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of **Gad** were sealed twelve thousand.

6 Of the tribe of **Aser** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of **Nephtalim** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of **Manasses** were sealed twelve thousand.

7 Of the tribe of **Simeon** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of **Levi** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of **Issachar** were sealed twelve thousand.

8 Of the tribe of **Zabulon** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of **Joseph** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of **Benjamin** were sealed twelve thousand.

Dan Betrayed Joseph so his portion was given to Joseph and Josephs son Mannesseh.

The betrayer in the twelve apostles was Judas whom the serpent entered.

Luke 22:3 Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.

John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not **I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?**

71 **He spake of Judas** Iscariot the son of Simon: for he it was **that should betray him, being one of the twelve.**

This is the two whom Christ was asked about sitting on the right hand and left hand.

Matt 20:20 Then came to him the mother of Zebedees children with her sons, worshipping him, and desiring a certain thing of him.

John was granted to sit at Christs side.

21 And he said unto her, What wilt thou? She saith unto him, **Grant that these my two sons may sit, the one on thy right hand, and the other on the left, in thy kingdom.**

22 But Jesus answered and said, Ye know not what ye ask. Are ye able to drink of the cup that I shall drink of, and to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with? They say unto him, We are able.

23 And he saith unto them, Ye shall drink indeed of my cup, and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with: **but to sit on my right hand, and on my left, is not mine to give, but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared of my Father.**

24 And when **the ten heard it**, they were moved with indignation against **the two brethren.**

You see they had twelve children and this story alludes to one of the twelve children being chosen each.

What we see in the Revelation is the two favoured elders talking to each other.

John and Joseph.

This is two prophets in heaven testifying of the prophesy of the great tribulation of 1260 days.

Rev 7:13 And **one of the elders** answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they?

14 And **I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest.** And he said to me, **These are they which came out of great tribulation**, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

This is two prophets testifying in heaven of the great tribulation 1260 days.

Rev 11:3 And **I will give power unto my two witnesses**, and **they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; **because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.**

This is two prophets on earth testifying of the 1260 days of the great tribulation on earth.

Matt 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

On earth as it is in heaven.

This is the prophesy of the elder who spoke to John.

The prophesy of the two seated at the right and left of Christ.

The prophesy of the two prophets in heaven testifying of the 1260 days.
