1. Congo	The Belgian ambassador in Leopold-ville says that the Congo "looks bad on all fronts." He does not think that present government forces are up to rescuing the non-Congolese in rebel areas. Only a major new infusion of mercenaries can save the situation. The rebels have now surrounded the mercenary force at Paulis and have retaken Aketi. They are also gaining strength in Cuvette-Centrale. (See map.)	50X1
