## 1. Berlin air corridors

Yesterday's Soviet announcement in the Berlin Air Safety Center postponing "indefinitely" further corridor "reservations" probably reflects a desire to stop short of risking a show-down test of stamina on air Their immediate aims in this manipulated crisis were to point up the vulnerability of the air access routes and emphasize the USSR's stated refusal to maintain the status quo for a prolonged period. The Berlin press and population have reacted calmly to the flap and appear to be taking it in stride.
