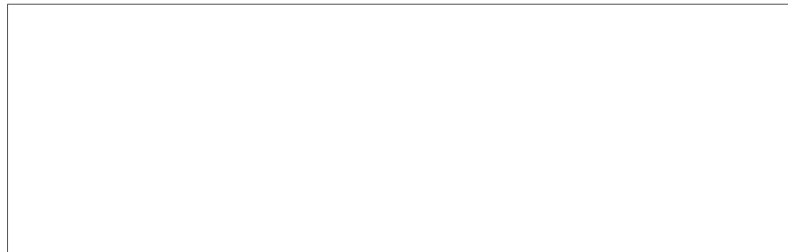

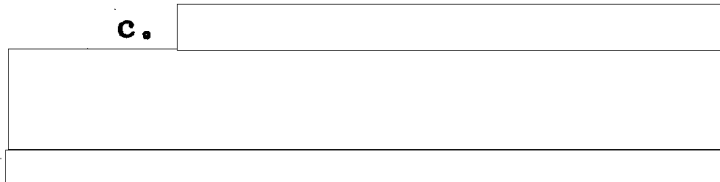
1. Laos

Malaya

a. The Indonesians are livid. They say Malaya's Prime Minister Rahman has cancelled his secret meeting in Tokyo with Sukarno which had been scheduled for tomorrow.

b. They report that recent Sukarno statements on Malaysia have been cited as the reason; Foreign Minister Subandrio claims that Sukarno had actually "said nothing new."

c. Subandrio, highly agitated, has asked Ambassador Jones "What do they want--war?"

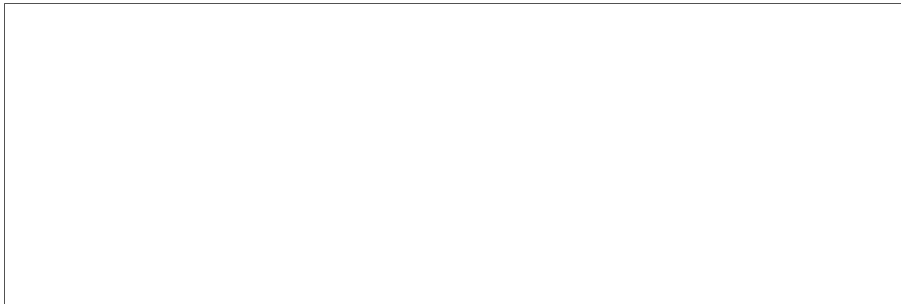

3. Cuba

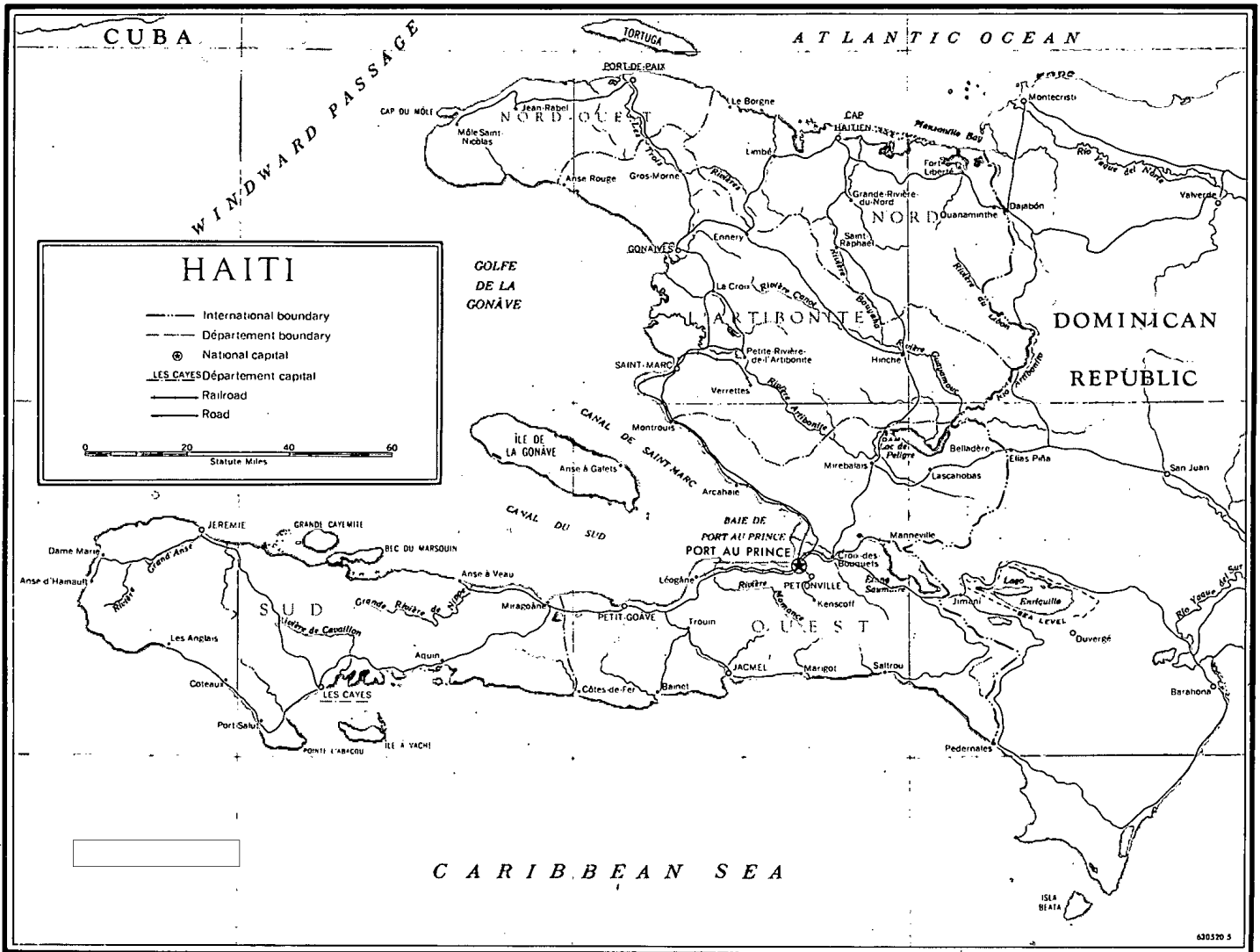

c. The Havana press says Castro will wind up his formal USSR visit next week and then will rest "for a few days" in the Crimea. The Algerian government, meanwhile, has announced without fanfare that Castro is expected at "the end of May or early June."

c. Two-thirds of the 700 al- ready there have applied for US visas.

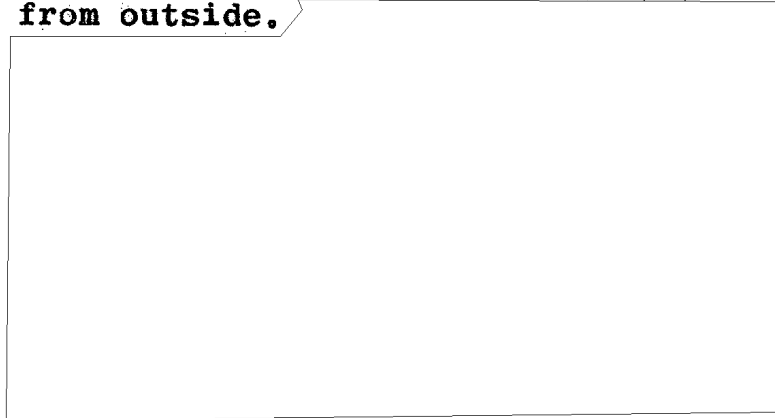
5. Haiti

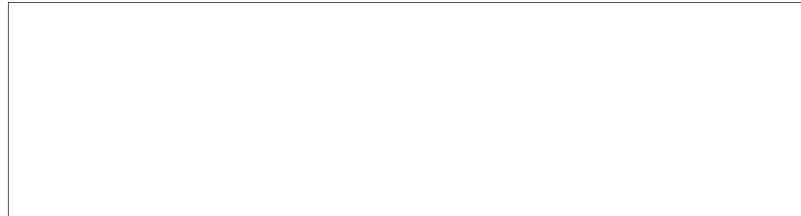

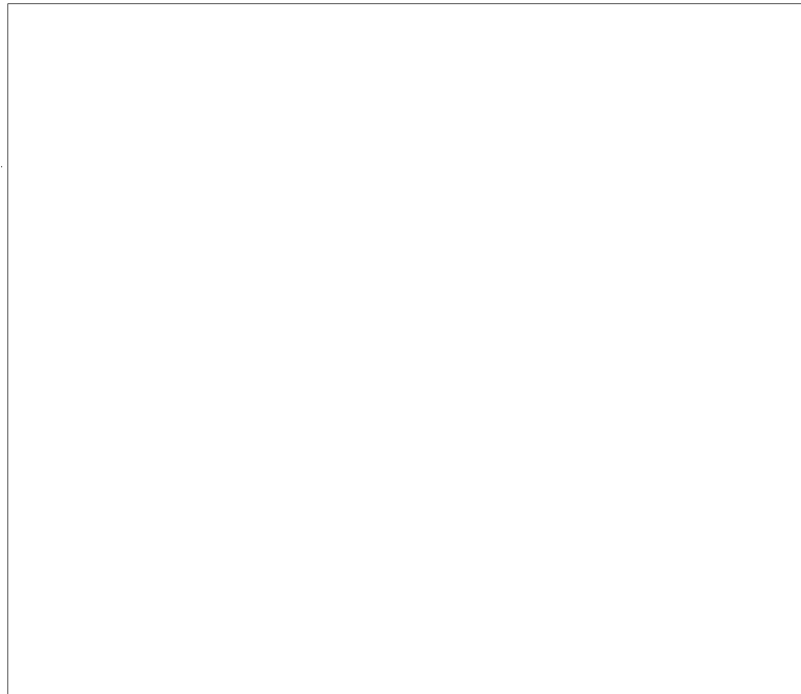

a. We think the Soviet proposal for declaring the Mediterranean a "zone free of nuclear-rocket weapons" is but the opening gun in an attack planned to greet

any announcement coming out of Ottawa on the Interallied Nuclear Force.

b. The tenor of recent propaganda suggests that Moscow will paint any NATO nuclear force as merely a device for giving Germany access to nuclear weapons. In Pravda two weeks ago, Malinovsky termed such access as "a direct threat" to Soviet "vital interests"--a formula hauled out by the USSR on the rarest of occasions.

c. Most, or all, Mediterranean nations have apparently received the Soviet proposal.
