

Red Sea prophesy of the End times.

I stood there in the vision and cursed the beasts armies to lose in war. Then I cursed the Red Sea to turn it to blood.

Then I saw Christ and the 3 angels with sickles come down over Petra in Edom and begin to reap the wicked from Bozrah to Jerusalem then up to Meggido.

I saw one angel grab the beast, I saw one angel grab the false prophet and then I saw one angel grab the dragon and bind him in the bottomless pit.

I saw blood flowing from Meggido to the Red sea up to a horse's bridle.

The blood flowed from Meggido through the Jordan valley emptying into the Red Sea and the Red Sea became as blood.

This was the vision I saw on the day of the Lord when the Red Sea bore its name.

Red sea is at the end of Jordan Valley.

Deut 1:1 These be the words which Moses spake unto all Israel **on this side Jordan in the wilderness**, in the plain over against the **Red sea**, between Paran, and Tophel, and Laban, and Hazeroth, and Dizahab.

The Winepress begins at EDOM Bozrah north of Petra

Isaiah 63 1:Who is this that cometh from **Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah?** this that is glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

2 Wherefore art thou red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat?

3 I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people there was none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.

4 For the day of vengeance is in mine heart, and the year of my redeemed is come..

This is Christ with his dyed garments of blood. Christ to tread the winepress with 3 angels. Blood up to horse's bridle forming a river of blood is found in the prophesy of revelation.

Rev 14:14 And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto **the Son of man**, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle.

15 And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe.



16 And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped.

17 And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle.

18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

20 And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, **by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs.**

1600 furlongs is approx 182 miles from Meggido valley down Jordan river into the Red sea..

Christ makes this war taking back earth and those fighting are turned to river of blood.

Rev 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge **and make war.**

Christ in war treading winepress in his robe dipped in blood.

Rev 19:13 And he was clothed with a **vesture dipped in blood:** and his name is called The Word of God.

14 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

The blood river is seen in the prophesy of Ezekiel.

Ezek 39:17 And, thou son of man, thus saith the Lord God; Speak unto every feathered fowl, and to every beast of the field, Assemble yourselves, and come; gather yourselves on every side to my sacrifice that I do sacrifice for you, even a great sacrifice upon the mountains of Israel, that ye may eat flesh, and **drink blood.**

18 Ye shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and **drink the blood of the princes of the earth,** of rams, of lambs, and of goats, of bullocks, all of them fatlings of Bashan.

19 And ye shall eat fat till ye be full, and drink blood till ye be drunken, of my sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you.

20 Thus ye shall be filled at my table with horses and chariots, with mighty men, and with all men of war, saith the Lord God.

This river of blood what birds drink from.

This same account of the river of blood is seen.

Rev 19:17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

This is the same account where birds eating flesh drinking blood river.

Ezek 32: 3 Thus saith the Lord God; I will therefore spread out my net over thee with a company of many people; and they shall bring thee up in my net.

4 Then will I leave thee upon the land, I will cast thee forth upon the open field, and will cause all the **fowls of the heaven to remain upon thee**, and I will fill the beasts of the whole earth with thee.

5 And I will lay thy **flesh upon the mountains, and fill the valleys with thy height**.

The valleys will be filled with the blood up to a horses bridle which is portion to the mans hieghth.

It continues on about the water in the land will be blood where they swim.

Ezek 32:6 I will also **water with thy blood the land wherein thou swimst**, even to the mountains; and the **rivers shall be full of thee**.

7 And when I shall put thee out, I will cover the heaven, and make the stars thereof dark; I will cover the sun with a cloud, and the moon shall not give her light.

8 All the bright lights of heaven will I make dark over thee, and set darkness upon thy land, saith the Lord God.

It further concludes about the day of the Lord when the sun and moon are darkened.

Wicked taken in the dark like thief in the night and righteous left. Wicked fed to birds is found in the prophetic warning of Christ. Notice it say in that Night.

Luke 17: 34 I tell you, **in that night** there shall be two men in one bed; the one shall be taken, and the other shall be left.

35 Two women shall be grinding together; the one shall be taken, and the other left.

36 Two men shall be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left.

37 And they answered and said unto him, Where, Lord? And he said unto them, **Whersoever the body is, thither will the eagles be gathered together.**

This river of blood is a finalising fulfilment of the cursing of the waters where the rivers turned to blood and the sea.

Power to turn all the waters into blood. Red Sea cursed to turn into blood. The Red Sea name is fulfilled.

Rev 11: 6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: **and have power over waters to turn them to blood**, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

The red Sea will become filled with blood and turn red and thus its name will be fulfilled.
