INGREDIENT NAME: Ketorolac Tablets (Kee toe ROLE ak)

WARNING: This drug may raise the chance of heart and blood vessel side effects like heart attack and stroke. If these happen, they can be deadly. The risk of these side effects may be greater if you have heart disease, high blood pressure, or disease or risk for heart disease. The risk of these health problems can happen as early as 1 week after you start taking this drug. The risk may be higher if you use it with long-term use. Do not use this drug right before or after bypass heart surgery. This drug may raise the chance of very bad and sometimes deadly stomach or intestinal bleeding. The risk of these health problems can happen as early as 1 week before these problems may occur without warning. In some cases, it may be life threatening. The risk is also greater in people who have had stomach or bowel ulcers or bleeding. Usual side effects it takes more than 5 days. Do not take more than what your doctor told you. Do not take this drug for longer than you were told by your doctor. Do not take this drug if you have ulcer, disease, very bad kidney problems, bleeding or any active bleeding like bleeding in the brain. Tell your doctor if you are pregnant or planning to get pregnant. Do not take if you have had an allergic reaction to this drug, aspirin or other NSAIDs like ibuprofen in the past. Do not take before, during, or after you get a flu shot. Do not take if you are pregnant and in labor. This drug is not approved for use in children. Talk with the doctor.

COMMON USES: It is used to ease pain.

BEFORE USING THIS MEDICINE: WHAT DO YOU NEED TO TELL YOUR DOCTOR BEFORE YOU TAKE THIS DRUG? TELL YOUR DOCTOR: If you have an allergy to any of these ingredients, tell your doctor. Tell your doctor if you are allergic to any drugs like this one, any other drugs, foods, or other substances. Tell your doctor about the allergy and what signs you had, like rash, hives, or itching; or any other signs. TELL YOUR DOCTOR: If you have gotten nasal polyps or had swelling of the mouth, face, lips, tongue, or throat. Tell your doctor if you have ever had any of these health problems: Ulcer, disease or bleeding in the stomach; liver problems; kidney problems; asthma; or if you are pregnant or planning to get pregnant. TELL YOUR DOCTOR: If you are pregnant or planning to get pregnant, you need to avoid this drug at other times during pregnancy. HOW TO USE THIS MEDICINE: HOW IS THIS DRUG BEST TAKEN? Use this drug exactly as your doctor has prescribed. Use as directed on the label. Read and follow the instructions closely. Take with or without food. Take with food if it gives an upset stomach or if you are nauseated. Do not take with a hot beverage. Take with an antacid if you are taking one. Do not take more than 2 tablets at the same time or more often than told by the doctor. Do not take more often than told by the doctor.

CAUTIONS: Tell all of your health care providers that you take this drug. This drug may increase your risk of bleeding. Tell your doctor if you have been told by the doctor, Talk with the doctor. High blood pressure has been told by your doctor. You may bleed more easily. Be careful and avoid injury. Use a soft toothbrush and an electric razor. If you have asthma, talk with your doctor before you take this drug. Tell your doctor if you are pregnant or planning to get pregnant. 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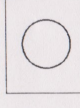
