

The prophesy of Christ being the Lamb from beggning of foundation of world.

In looking to the sacrifice of the lamb that was slain from foundation of the world and his book.

We look to the prophesy of the end and how it relates to the begining...

Rev 13:8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, **whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.**

We see this is the book of life of the lamb..

Rev 17:8 The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, **whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world**, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.

The beast is admired by the world who rejects the lamb of God. Those whose names are in the lambs book of life accept the lamb offering...

Getting your name in the lambs book of life is required the book of life from the begining...

Lamb skin covering adams sin was foreshadow of Christ sacrifice from the begining...

Adam and Eve tried to cover thier nakedness with vegetation and it wasnt enough...

Gen 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and **they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.**

So God clothed them with the skin of a lamb...

Genesis 3:21 Unto Adam also and to his wife did **the Lord God make coats of skins, and clothed them.**

The Lord clothed Adam and Eve with the lamb from the foundation of the world.

Abel also offered a lamb

Gene 4:2 And she again bare his brother Abel. And **Abel was a keeper of sheep**, but Cain was a tiller of the ground.

Gen4:3 And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the Lord.

Gen 4:4 And **Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock** and of the fat thereof. And the Lord had **respect unto Abel and to his offering:**

Gen 4:5 But unto **Cain and to his offering he had not respect.** And Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell.

So Abel offered a first born lamb... of his flock... from the begining of the foundation of the world...

Cain offered vegetation to cover him and not offering a lamb. God did not accept that offering...

Abraham likewise was asked to offer his only son and a lamb was provided by God in his place.

Gen 22:1 And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham: and he said, Behold, here I am.

Gen 33:2 And he said, **Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest**, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of.

Pay close attention to the notation that God made note that His only Son whom he lovest was asked to be offered and a lamb was offered in the place. This was foreshadow of Christ.

Johns said behold the lamb of God.

John 1:29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, **Behold the Lamb of God**, which taketh away the sin of the world.

John 1:36 And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, **Behold the Lamb of God!**

When Christ was baptised the Father confirmed that Christ was the only Son the lamb whom He lovest just like He said to Abraham about abrahams son...

Matt 3:17 And lo a **voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son**, in whom I am well pleased.

Christ in the likeness from the foundation of world of Adam and the first lamb sacrificed for Adam was foreshadow of Christ being the lamb that would be offered for all mankind to restore mankind.

Prophesy said a lamb would be slain is referencing Christ the Son of God.

Isaiah 53:7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: **he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter**, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

Those washed by the blood of the Lamb are worshiping the Lamb at the throne in heaven...

Rev 7:9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, **stood before the throne, and before the Lamb**, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

Rev7: 10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, **Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.**

They serve and worship the Lamb and he feeds them... His blood has washed them...

Rev 7:14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them **white in the blood of the Lamb.**

Rev7:15 Therefore are **they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple**: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.

Rev 7:16 They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat.

Rev 7:17 **For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them**, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.

The Lamb at the throne..

Rev 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, **in the midst of the throne** and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, **stood a Lamb as it had been slain**, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

Worship of the Lamb

Rev 5:9 And **they sung a new song**, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: **for thou wast slain**, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

Rev 5:12 Saying with a loud voice, **Worthy is the Lamb that was slain** to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.

Rev 5:13 And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that **sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.**

On the Return of Christ the Lamb of God brings wrath on those who fight against His earthly rule.

Those who accept the Lamb of God are married to Him as the King.

Rev 19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for **the marriage of the Lamb is come**, and his wife hath made herself ready.

Those who reject Him and fight against His coming... they try to hide and run from the Lambs wrath... which is the wrath of God...

Rev 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from **the wrath of the Lamb:**

Rev 6:17 For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?

Here is the wrath of God, the wrath of the Lambs winepress.

Rev 19:15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and **wrath of Almighty God.**

on the millenium reign of Christ in the end you cannot enter the city of God unless you have your name written in the lambs book of life accepting His sacrifice.

Rev 21:27 And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but **they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.**

City of the Millenium rule of Christ the Lamb is the Light ...

Rev 21:23 And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and **the Lamb is the light thereof.**

After the 1000 year reign of the Lamb those who were not in the first resurrection are resurrected of the dead of all mankind from the begining and those who dont have thier name in the lambs book of life are thrown into the lake of fire..

Rev 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, **which is the book of life:** and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

Rev 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

Rev20:14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

Rev20:15 And **whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.**

If you do not have the atonement of the Lamb slain from the foundatoin of the world which is Christ the Son of God you will be thrown into the lake of fire after the 1000 years reign of Christ.

Wash your self with the blood of the Lamb of God who was slain for you and be spared and your name will be written in the Lambs book of life...

otherwise you will be with the rest of the world who is uniting with the Antichrist who is going to the lake of fire...

Rev 13:8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, **whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.**
