1. Communists increase guerrilla activity in northern South Vietnam

Two government posts north of Kontum were captured last week by a Communist force of about 1,000; the Diem government says two North Vietnamese battalions were involved, but we doubt it. Government forces retook both posts on Monday, but were not strong enough to pursue the attackers. The government reported 100 rebel and 19 friendly dead; actual South Vietnamese Army losses were 35 killed, 49 wounded, 25 missing. It appears that Diem's Civil Guard also lost 170 in these engagements.
