## DAILY BRIEF 17 DECEMBER 1966

Mobutu is brewing up something but the broth is still murky. Late reports indicate the government is being reorganized and that additional troops are being sent to Katanga.

Mobutu's negotiations with Belgian mining interests in the Congo have been deadlocked and he has given the company until 1 January to meet his terms.

It is conceivable he may be planning some move against Belgian-owned property in Katanga if the deadline is not met. 50X1
