1. PRESIDENTS' CONFERENCE:

A. AS PART OF ITS SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE MEETING, THE COSTA RICAN GOVERNMENT WILL CLOSE ITS BORDERS BETWEEN 16 AND 20 MARCH.

2. SOVIET PERSONNEL IN CUBA:

A. THE ADMIRAL NAKHIMOV SAILED FROM HAVANA YESTERDAY.

3. CUBA/LATIN AMERICA:

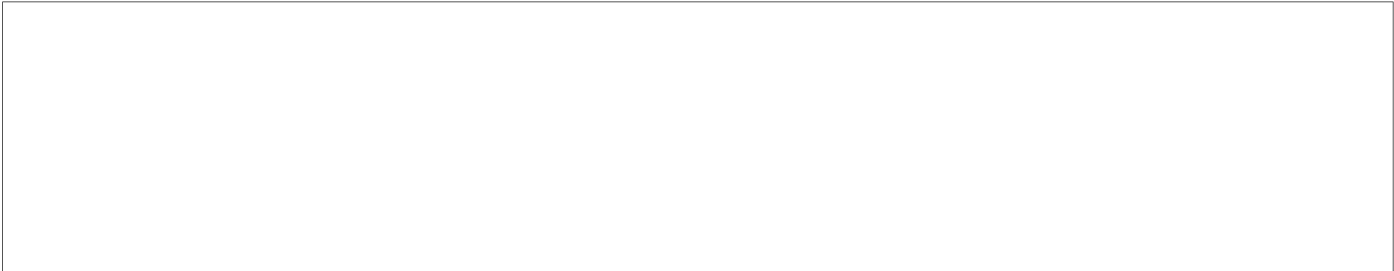

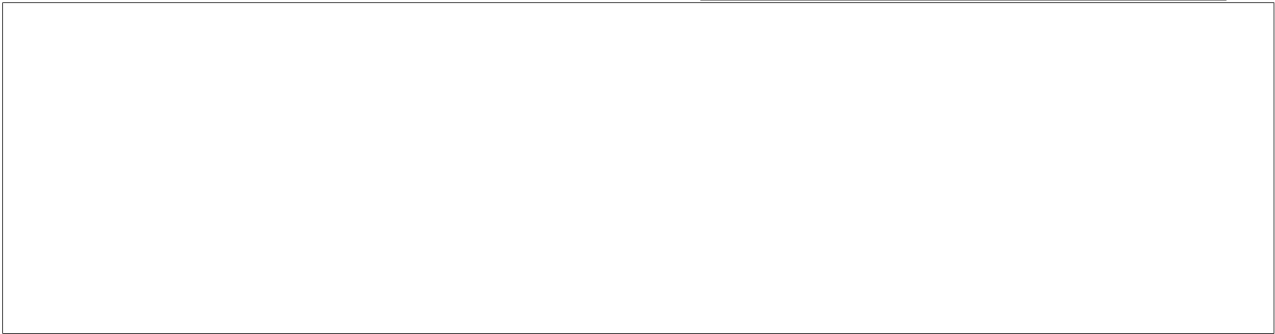

B. THERE WERE NO OUTWARD SIGNS OF IMPENDING TROUBLE IN THE HAITIAN CAPITAL

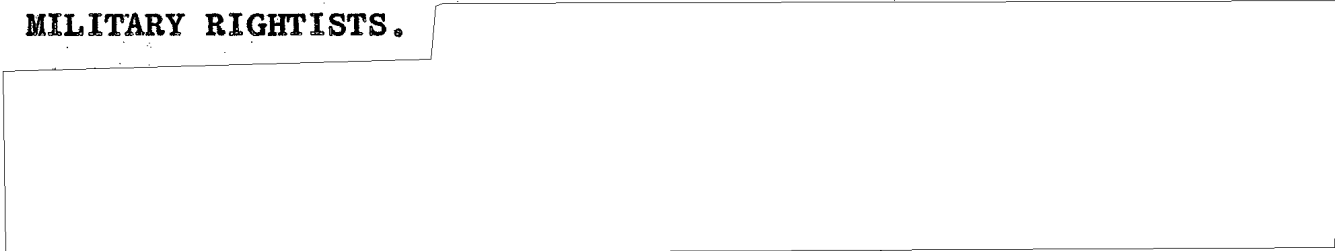

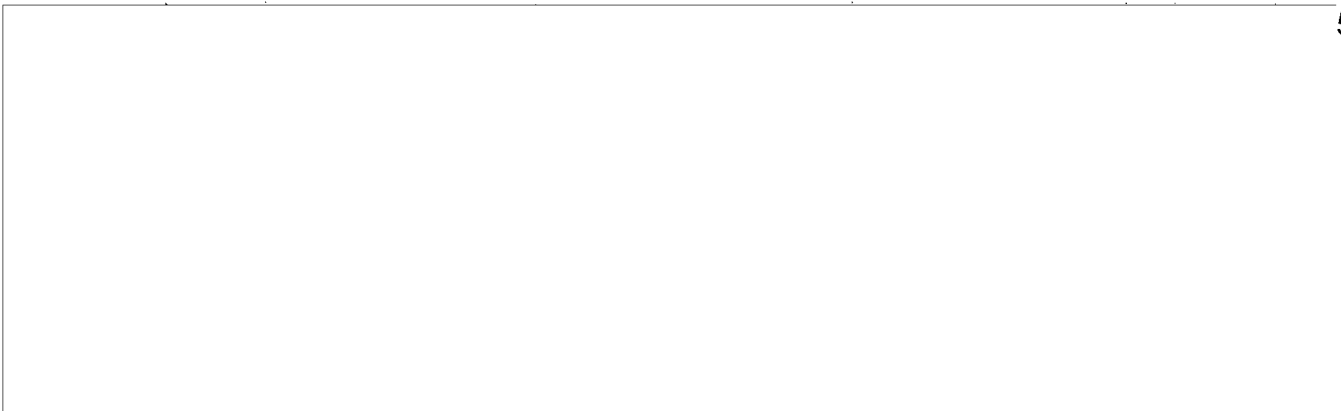
