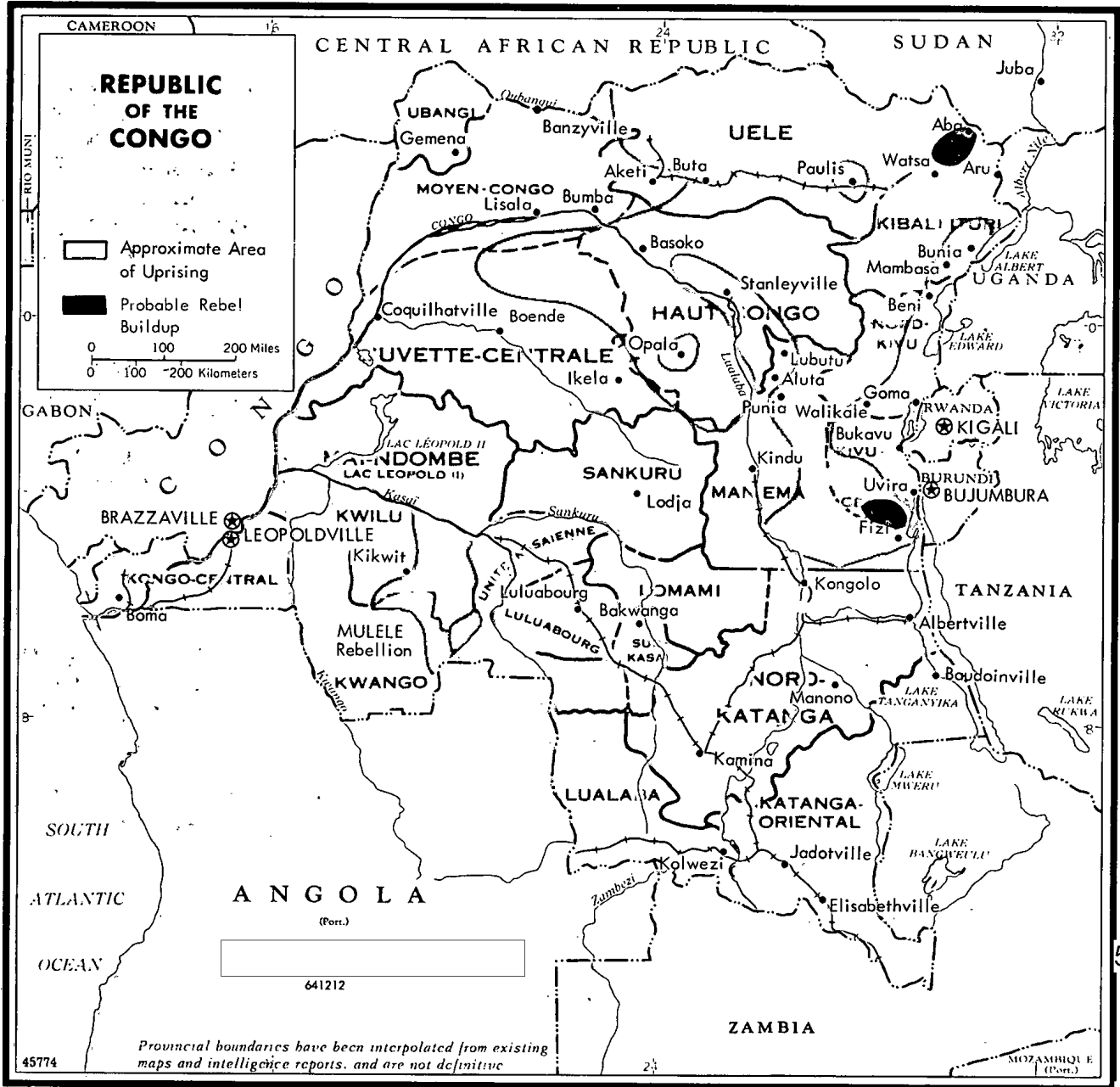

Tshombé's vital mercenary force has been reduced [redacted] and he has fewer planes for air support than he had two months ago. The rebel buildup continues.

Buddhist leaders have plans for a new and larger hunger strike tomorrow.

5. UK

Members of the Common Market intend to press the Council of the General Agreement on Trade and Tariffs (GATT), which meets Thursday, for a formal finding that the Wilson government's emergency import taxes violate the General Agreement. This could release a new round of speculative pressures against the pound.
